FREE Curbside Clean Up

Our next FREE community-wide clean up for residents of single-family dwellings in Desert Hot Springs will start Monday, April 23rd.

- This is a curbside ONLY event. You do not need to contact us to arrange collection.
- Limits:
 - Two bulky items, **OR**
 - Four containers of excess trash, **OR**
 - Two bundles of yard waste.
- Place your bulky items or contained waste items at the curb **by 6:00 A.M., Monday, April 23rd**.

Our crews will make one pass only through the City during the week collecting these materials.

As a reminder, please donate reusable items to a community organization; many offer collection.

Document Shredding & Electronic Waste Recycling Event

Our next FREE Document Shredding and Electronic Waste Collection event will occur April 28th in the parking lot of the Carl May Community Center 8 AM to Noon.

At this event we accept up to three (3) file boxes or equivalent per household (single-family only).

We will also accept up to four (4) electronic products (printers, computers & peripherals, fax machines, cell phones, televisions, etc.) per household.

[Holiday Reminder](#)

We will observe Memorial Day on Monday, May 28th and Independence Day on Wednesday, July 4th. Collections scheduled for those days and the remaining days of those weeks will occur one day late.

[House Numbers](#)

The wind will topple or move your trash and recycling carts. We recommend that you identify your carts by identifying your house number on each with a permanent marker or paint. This will make it easier to identify and retrieve them.



[Mandatory Construction & Demolition Debris Recycling](#)

The Desert Hot Springs Municipal Code requires property owners and contractors to divert construction and demolition debris from the landfill. The Municipal Code requires applicants to file a plan, a surety guarantee, and a final report proving diversion. We are authorized by the City to help you streamline the process and bypass the plan-surety-reporting requirements. Call for details.

[Bins & Debris Boxes](#)

We offer 3-cubic yard bins and 10-, 20-, 30-, and 40-cubic yard boxes for construction & demolition debris recycling. Construction containers are available by the week or the month.



[Food Waste & Yard Trimmings](#)

State law (AB 1826) requires businesses that generate 4 or more cubic yards of organic waste to separate it for recycling. The term "organic waste" means food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, nonhazardous wood waste and food-soiled paper waste that is mixed in with food waste. We can assist your business with these services. (Multi-family properties are NOT required to separate food waste but are required to recycle plant material.) Call for details.
